Celebrating 130 years of the Manx Electric Railway 10 September 2023

Dear Garff constituent

Community is at the heart of what makes the Isle of Man a special place to live and I am lucky to have witnessed some encouraging developments in the past year. The launch of the Laxey skiff (pictured overleaf) was a wonderful culmination of 10 months' work by a small group of people, with hopefully more to follow.

I am acutely aware, however, that the lack of affordable housing and cost of living concerns result in some people having to move out of our community. Progress on delivering the housing strategy has been slow.

Delays in the Area Plan for the North and West is unfortunate as it is hoped this will result in designation of some development land in Maughold - bringing much needed housing and boosting the numbers for local schools.

I have also highlighted in the past year the worrying levels of ultra processed food in school menus, and I am pleased that is being reviewed.

The state of the Island's finances and provision of health and education services continue to be the main political focus. As a member of the Social Affairs parliamentary scrutiny committee, the lack of NHS dentists, especially for children, prompted our first report seeking improvements. I opposed the proposal for IoM Public Health to research adding fluoride to our water - and will keep an eye on that report (due February).

Road safety remains a priority across Lonan, Laxey and Onchan, and I continue to engage with Garff road safety community partnership and Highways officers on various matters, not least improving roads, footpaths and road crossings.

The year 2023 was a significant one for the Island's heritage railways, and it was a pleasure to see the well-attended 130th anniversary celebrations of the Manx Electric Railway. However, I remain concerned about the future retention and operation of our railway network in light of transport consultants SYSTRA's long-awaited review. I support more efficient ways of operating our heritage assets but they must be adequately funded. Savings should not be achieved through reductions to the remaining rail network or attractions.

I welcome news that Laxey Wheel restoration will continue through 2024-25 with repairs to the rod duct and T-rocker.

Two other matters that generate much discussion are concerned with democratic representation in our parliament: There is a public consultation on whether the Lord Bishop should continue to have a vote in our parliament. Details available in the media but please contact me if you would like assistance to take part (closing date 29 February 2024).

The Electoral Commission is due to report soon on constituency boundaries and voting accessibility (amongst other things). Should community boundaries or equalising voter numbers determine a constituency? I would welcome constituents' views on the recommendations, which are due soon.

I always welcome feedback and comments on these or any issues that concern you. Please drop in to any of the political surgeries listed overleaf or contact me to arrange meetings or phone discussions outside these times.
